SB 1611 - HB 2119

SUMMARY OF BILL: Expands the Tennessee Rehabilitative Initiative in Correction's (TRICOR) authority to develop joint ventures with nonprofit businesses and governmental entities.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 41-22-116(e), the TRICOR Board is authorized to develop joint ventures that operate pursuant to the Private Sector Prison Industry Enhancement Certification Program with private sector businesses.
- TRICOR is self-sufficient and generates revenue through the sale of products and services.
- Any joint venture developed by TRICOR will operate in a manner to maintain self-sufficiency; therefore, any fiscal impact to state or local government resulting from the proposed legislation is estimated to be not significant.
