SB 1809 - HB 2120

February 21, 2020

SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes the Tennessee Rehabilitative Initiative in Correction (TRICOR) to enter into contractual agreements with counties and cities to provide work training programs for prisoners incarcerated in county and city jails.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

On February 18, 2020, a fiscal note was issued estimating a fiscal impact as follows:

Other Fiscal Impact – To the extent TRICOR enters into a contractual agreement with a city or county, TRICOR will experience an increase in expenditures and revenue. Cities and counties may experience a corresponding increase in expenditures and revenue. The timing and amount of any such impacts cannot be quantified with reasonable certainty.

After further analysis, the estimated fiscal impact has been corrected as follows:

Corrected Assumptions:

- TRICOR is self-sufficient and generates revenue through the sale of products and services.
- Any authorized TRICOR contract agreement will operate in a manner to maintain self-sufficiency; therefore, any fiscal impact to state or local government resulting from the proposed legislation is estimated to be not significant.
