FISCAL NOTE

SB 1845 - HB 2599

February 18, 2020

SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes a sentencing court to reduce a probation sentence by 30 days for each 30 consecutive days of probation served without a probation violation.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 40-35-308(a), during a term of probation supervision, a sentencing court is authorized to:
 - Modify any condition;
 - Remove a condition; or
 - Release the defendant from further supervision, provided certain criteria are met.
- Any fiscal impact to the court system or the Board of Parole resulting from specifying that the sentencing court is authorized to reduce a probation sentence in the specified circumstance is estimated to be not significant.
