SUMMARY OF BILL: Increases, from eight to twelve, the maximum number of meetings for which members of the Carter County Parks and Recreation Board are compensated annually.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

**Increase Local Expenditures –
Up to \$1,800/FY20-21 and Subsequent Years/Permissive/Carter County**

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 11-24-104(b), Carter County is authorized to create a recreation board. Any board created shall contain nine members who shall be compensated at a rate of \$50 per meeting, with a maximum of eight paid meetings occurring each year.
- Any increase in compensation for Board members of the Carter County Parks and Recreation Board is considered a mandatory cost on a permissive action.
- The Carter County Parks and Recreation Board met 5 times in 2016, 8 times in 2017, 8 times in 2018, and 4 times in 2019.
- Increasing the maximum number of meetings for which such Board members are compensated will result in a permissive, recurring increase in local expenditures of up to \$1,800 (\$50 per member x 9 members x 4 additional meetings), beginning in FY20-21.
