**FISCAL NOTE**

**SB 2032 – HB 2588**

February 6, 2020

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Adds a thirty-minute video on adverse childhood experiences to the parent education seminar which parents who are subject to a permanent parenting plan must attend.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 36-6-408, the fees or costs to attend a parent education seminar are borne by the attending parents.
- Such seminars are generally held by private entities; therefore, any increase in costs to include a 30-minute video on adverse childhood experiences would be borne first by such entities and then passed down to attending parents.
