FISCAL NOTE

SB 2088 - HB 2461

February 28, 2020

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires each local education agency (LEA) and public charter school to designate a child abuse coordinator and an alternate child abuse coordinator for each school within the LEA and public charter school. Requires each LEA and each public charter school to ensure all school officials and other school personnel annually complete the child abuse training program. Establishes procedures for personnel to adhere to following the disclosure, discovery, or suspicion of child abuse or child sexual abuse.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- LEAs and public charter schools will be able to comply with the proposed legislation within existing resources.
- LEAs and public charter schools will be able to amend their policies in accordance with the provisions of this legislation during the normal course of business; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
