FISCAL NOTE

SB 2089 - HB 2135

February 14, 2020

SUMMARY OF BILL: Expands the teen pregnancy rate age criteria for a county to include 18 and 19 year old females for the purposes of requiring LEAs to implement a family life education program once pregnancy rates exceed 19.5 pregnancies per one thousand females ages 15 through 19. Prohibits a person from making abortion referrals or advocating for abortion while a person is on school property, at an LEA-sponsored event, or during provision of services to an LEA or public school.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The proposed legislation may increase the number of LEAs required to implement a family life education program; however, LEAs are currently equipped to teach family life and would be able to comply with program requirements resulting from the proposed legislation within existing resources.
- Prohibiting persons from making abortion referrals or advocating for abortion in specified circumstances will not result in a significant impact on state or local government.
- No significant impact to state or local operations.
