SB 2268 - HB 2383

February 5, 2020

SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes a political subdivision to release the name or photograph of a minor victim of a criminal offense for the purpose of memorializing, if the parent or legal guardian consents.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 10-7-504(t), the following information concerning the minor victim of a criminal offense is required to be confidential: name, home, work, and electronic mail addresses, telephone numbers, social security number, any photographic or video of the victim, and whether the defendant is related to the victim unless the relationship is an essential element of the offense. This provision is not to be construed to limit certain functions of law enforcement or courts.
- Authorizing a political subdivision to release the name or photograph of the minor victim of a criminal offense, with the consent of the parent or guardian, specifically for the purposes of memorializing the minor victim will not result in a significant fiscal impact to state or local government.
