FISCAL NOTE

SB 2277 – HB 2622

February 6, 2020

SUMMARY OF BILL: Increases, from within 45 to within 60, the days from the date of judgement that a court clerk is required to forward a copy of the judgement required to be included on the Drug Offender Registry to the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 39-17-436(d), court clerks are required to forward a copy of the judgment and date of birth of all persons required to be published on the Drug Offender Registry within 45 days of the date of judgment.
- Increasing the timeframe in which court clerks are required to forward a copy of a judgement by 15 days will not have a significant impact on state or local expenditures.
