**FISCAL NOTE**

**SB 2281 - HB 2394**

February 18, 2020

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Revises reporting requirements of the Attorney General and Reporter (AG).

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- The proposed legislation requires the AG to notify the Director of the Office of Legal Services and the Director of the Fiscal Review Committee of any of the following actions that are filed in state or federal court in which the state is a party and the state is represented by the AG if:
  - The adjudication or settlement of an action could result in a significant increase in state expenditures;
  - The adjudication or settlement of an action could result in a significant increase in revenue for the state;
  - A decision on a policy issue could be rendered that may result in a significant increase in state expenditures;
  - A decision on a policy issue could be rendered that may result in a significant decrease in state expenditures; or
  - A decision could affect the bond rating of the state.
- Based on information provided by the AG, any additional duties resulting from the proposed legislation will be absorbed using existing resources.
