FISCAL NOTE

SB 2316 - HB 2617

February 11, 2020

SUMMARY OF BILL: Increases, from at least 30 to at least 60 days prior to the expiration of a certificate of registration or license, the period of time in which the Department of Commerce and Insurance (DCI) is required to send written notice to a fire protection sprinkler system contractor of the impending expiration.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Increasing the time in which DCI is required to send notice to a fire protection sprinkler system contractor of impending expiration before a certificate or license expires can be accomplished within existing resources.
- No significant fiscal impact to state or local government.

IMPACT TO COMMERCE:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- Increasing the time in which DCI is required to send a fire protection sprinkler system contractor notice of expiration before a certificate or license expires will have no significant impact to jobs or commerce in Tennessee.
