FISCAL NOTE

SB 2437 - HB 2693

February 21, 2020

SUMMARY OF BILL: Establishes that a teacher, principal school employee, or school bus driver is immune from civil liability when exercising use of force as defined in Tenn. Code Ann. § 49-6-4107 unless the teacher's, principal's, school employee's, or school bus driver's conduct is the result of gross negligence or willful or wanton misconduct.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Current law pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 49-6-4107 authorizes teachers, principals, school employees or bus drivers to use reasonable force when necessary.
- The proposed legislation confers civil immunity for those using it unless their conduct is deemed to be grossly negligent, willful, or wanton.
- The Department of Education, schools, and school employees will be able to comply with the proposed legislation within existing resources.
- No significant impact to state or local operations.
