SUMMARY OF BILL: Clarifies that the Department of Health (DOH) and the Department of Human Services' (DHS) joint annual report on the options available to the state and the extent of federal financial participation for each option, under Medicaid and Temporary Assistance for Needy Families must also be provided to the legislative reference, law library, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 68-1-110, DOH and DHS must provide the joint annual report to the Health and Welfare Committee of the Senate and the Health Committee of the House of Representatives.
- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 3-1-123, any report that is required to be filed with a committee of the General Assembly must also be filed with the legislative reference, the law library, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives.
- No fiscal impact to state government.
