SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires any person, or that person's authorized agent who is asserting a potential claim for health care liability based on a claim of exposure to or contraction of coronavirus, to include in the required written notice to be given to each health care provider that will be named defendant at least 60 days before filing a complaint based upon health care liability in any court of this state, the date and location on which the person alleges the exposure or contraction occurred.
