SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires any person vested with the authority to make an arrest in the State of Tennessee to be a participant in an authorized undercover operation, authorized to wear plain clothes on duty, or to wear a uniform meeting the outlined criteria that clearly identifies him or herself as an agent or officer when arresting a person during a protest or demonstration.
