FISCAL NOTE

SUMMARY OF BILL: Designates the bridge spanning Sinking Creek on State Route 91 (Elizabethton Highway) in the central community of Carter County as the *"Mike and Sara Sellers Memorial Bridge"* and directs the Department of Transportation (TDOT) to erect suitable signs. Resolves that the cost associated with the manufacture and installation of such signs be paid to TDOT from non-state funds within one year of the effective dates.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Other Fiscal Impact – Not Significant to State or Local Government – However, to the extent non-state funds are received from a local government entity, there will be a permissive one-time increase in local government expenditures estimated to be \$300.

Assumptions:

- The cost to manufacture and install one sign is estimated to be \$150.
- Two signs will be required to designate the bridge as proposed.
- The total one-time cost to designate the bridge as proposed is estimated to be \$300 (2 signs x 150).
- Passage of this resolution will not result in any significant impact to state government.
- Non-state funds may include private funding or local government funding.
