**FISCAL NOTE**

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Requires the State Capitol Commission to initiate creation and placement in the State Capitol of a bust to honor Vice Admiral William Porter Lawrence.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**Increase State Expenditures – Up to \$25,000/One-Time**

Assumptions:

- The proposed resolution requests that the Tennessee Arts Commission sponsor a contest, which will be open to all interested artists, to select such a monument to honor Vice Admiral Lawrence.
- Furthermore, the proposed resolution requests that the funding for this monument come from a state appropriation, but authorizes the State Capitol Commission to seek private donations to cover the cost of the monument and related expenses.
- The exact cost of such bust is unknown; however, the 2014 Appropriation Act, Public Chapter 919, included \$25,000 for the Davy Crockett bust.
- Due to uncertainty regarding the amount of contributions, if any, from private donations that will be used to cover the cost of this monument, the one-time increase in state expenditures is estimated to be up to \$25,000.
