SUMMARY OF BILL: Urges the President of the United States, Congress, the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, the Tennessee Valley Authority, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, and the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency to provide assistance, including, but not limited to, the provision of assistance to local organizations, such as the Chamber of Commerce, to aggressively address the Asian carp invasion of Tennessee waterways. Requires copies of the resolution to be transmitted to various recipients.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Assumptions:

- Urging the listed governmental agencies as well as various local organizations to aid in combating the Asian carp invasion of Tennessee waterways will not have an impact on state or local government.
