by deleting all language after the enacting clause and by substituting instead the following:

SECTION 1. When Hepatitis A outbreaks in communities are of such a nature and proportion that the Centers for Disease Control and/or the Commissioner of Health deems it appropriate to do targeted or widespread vaccination for Hepatitis A, then vaccine will be made available to that community through state funds, if no federal vaccine program will cover the cost of any or all of the vaccine necessary to carry out the vaccination program.

SECTION 2. For the purpose of funding the cost of the vaccine required by the bill during such outbreaks, it is the legislative intent to provide a "sum-sufficient" appropriation in each fiscal year's annual appropriation bill which will be subject to approval of the Commissioner of Finance and Administration.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect on July 1, 1996, the public welfare requiring it.
