AMEND Senate Bill No. 2180*

House Bill No. 2763

by adding the following section to precede the effective date section:

SECTION _____. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 68-211-851, is amended by adding a new subsection thereto, as follows:

() (1) Not later than July 1, 1997, each county which maintains and uses receptacles for the collection of municipal solid waste from the general public at sites separate from a convenience center for the needs of the residents of the county shall submit the following information to the department:

(A) The number of receptacles in the county;

(B) The location of all receptacles;

(C) Collection times for such receptacles;

(D) Operation procedures and security measures adopted and enforced to maintain and service the receptacles and to ensure the protection of public health and safety; and

(E) Such other information required by the department.

(2) The board created pursuant to Section 68-211-111 shall promulgate rules and regulations on the requirements for operation and use of such receptacles as it deems necessary to ensure the protection of public health and safety and to provide for the proper management of solid waste disposed in such receptacles. Any county which does not submit the information required by subdivision (1) of this subsection or which violates the rules and regulations of the board created pursuant to Section 68-211-111 shall not use such receptacles for such purposes.

(3) The provisions of this subsection shall only apply to counties which had receptacles in use on January 1, 1996. A county which did not have receptacles in use on January 1, 1996, or which subsequent to such date discontinues use of any receptacle permitted under this section, shall be prohibited from installing or maintaining additional receptacles after the effective date of this act.
