AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-7-119,
relative to fees for higher education.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-7-119(a), is amended by deleting such subsection in its entirety and by substituting instead the following new language:

(a) Every child in Tennessee under the age of twenty-four (24) whose parent is employed as a full-time certified teacher in any public school in Tennessee, or whose parent holds any valid professional certification and is employed by any public school system, shall receive a twenty-five percent (25%) discount on tuition to any state-operated institution of higher learning.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1995, the public welfare requiring it.
