AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 49, relative to  
Community Learning Centers.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 49, Chapter 8, Part 6, is amended by  
adding the following language as a new section:

In order to revitalize inner-city areas and improve the opportunities of its  
inhabitants, the legislature declares that "Community Learning Centers" be established  
in these under-served communities. These centers would be a "brain-trust", where the  
youth of Tennessee can go for mental, rather than physical development, such as  
learning about computers rather than basketball.

The University of Memphis is authorized to institute a pilot program of one (1)  
"Community Learning Center", whose sole purpose is the development of children's  
minds by exposing them to information systems and other technology necessary for a  
successful life.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring  
it.
