AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 9, Chapter 6,
Part 1, relative to appropriations for appeals of capital
cases.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1., is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately
designated section:

Section _____. No state funds for appeals of capital cases shall be appropriated
for nor allocated to a non-profit corporation exempted from the payment of federal
income taxes by the United States Internal Revenue Code (26 U.S.C. 501(c)(3)) which
operates on federal or state grants.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring
it.
