AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 63-4-112,
relative to chiropractic licenses.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 63-4-112(c), is amended by deleting subdivision (1) in its entirety and by substituting instead the following:

(1) The board shall renew a licensee's certificate of fitness upon application made in due form and upon payment of all required fees; provided, that such licensee has submitted upon application for renewal a certificate of attendance of a board approved chiropractic educational program. All continuing education seminars shall be monitored for compliance of subject material by a designated professional board member who shall sign a certificate of proof of attendance for each licensee.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 63-4-112(c), is further amended by deleting subdivision (2) in its entirety and by substituting instead the following:

(2) The board shall set the seminar subject material and hours to ensure clinical compliance of licensees each year on, or before, December 31, for the ensuing year in which those seminars are to be conducted. The board designees shall proof and submit

on the agenda of the next scheduled or special called meeting for the board's ratification of approved material, fees and location of seminars to be conducted for license renewal compliance.

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 63-4-112(c), is further amended by deleting subdivision (3) in its entirety.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
