

AN ACT relative to the terms of office of the members of the board of Mayor and Aldermen of the town of Ridgely, Tennessee and to amend Chapter 297 of the Private Acts of 1909, as amended by Chapter 808 of the Private Acts of 1925, Chapter 71 of the Private Acts of 1927, Chapter 629 of the Private Acts of 1929, Chapter 530 of the Private Acts of 1935, Chapter 315 of the Private Acts of 1953, and any other acts amendatory thereto.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Section 3 of Chapter 297 of the Private Acts of 1909, as amended by Chapter 808 of the Private Acts of 1925, Chapter 71 of the Private Acts of 1927, Chapter 629 of the Private Acts of 1929, Chapter 530 of the Private Acts of 1935, Chapter 315 of the Private Acts of 1953, and any other acts amendatory thereto, is amended by deleting the section in its entirety and by substituting instead the following:

Section 3. On the second Tuesday in June 1995, and on the second Tuesday in June every four (4) years thereafter, an election shall be held at the customary voting place, or places, in the town for the purpose of electing a Mayor and six (6) Aldermen, who shall hold office for four (4) years, or until their successors are elected and qualified. The Board of Mayor and Aldermen may, by ordinance, change the date and place of holding the election, however, such change, if any, shall not limit or affect the four (4) year term of office herein set forth.

SECTION 2. This act shall have no effect unless it is approved by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the board of mayor and aldermen of the town of Ridgely before June 1, 1995. Its approval or nonapproval shall be proclaimed by the presiding officer of the board of mayor and aldermen and certified by him to the secretary of state.

SECTION 3. For the purpose of approving or rejecting the provisions of this act, it shall be effective upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes, it shall become effective upon being approved as provided in Section 2.
