

AN ACT to amend Chapter 67 of the Private Acts of 1953, as amended by Chapter 97 of the Private Acts of 1981, Chapter 195 of the Private Acts of 1990, and all other acts amendatory thereto, relative to the compensation of the board of mayor and aldermen of the City of Gallatin.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Chapter 67 of the Private Acts of 1953, as amended by Chapter 97 of the Private Acts of 1981, Chapter 195 of the Private Acts of 1990, and all other acts amendatory thereto, is amended by deleting from Article III, Section 5, the language "fifty dollars (\$50.00)" in the fourth sentence and by substituting instead the language "one hundred dollars (\$100)".

SECTION 2. Chapter 67 of the Private Acts of 1953, as amended, is further amended by deleting from Article III, Section 5, the language "twenty-five dollars (\$25.00)" in the fourth sentence and by substituting instead the language "fifty dollars (\$50.00)".

SECTION 3. Nothing in this act shall be construed as having the effect of altering the salary of any incumbent prior to the end of the term for which such public officer was elected.

SECTION 4. This act shall have no effect unless it is approved by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the legislative body of the City of Gallatin. Its approval or nonapproval shall be proclaimed by the presiding officer of the City of Gallatin and certified to the secretary of state.

SECTION 5. For the purpose of approving or rejecting the provisions of this act, it shall be effective upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes, it shall become effective upon being approved as provided in Section 4 and shall be implemented with the terms of office beginning January 1, 1998.
