A RESOLUTION to congratulate Virginia Hudson for being selected as the 1994 Outstanding Volunteer of the Year.

WHEREAS, serving others plays a major role in her life, as she prepares a number of adults to take the General Education Development Test, often referred to as the G.E.D.; and

WHEREAS, the G.E.D. is equivalent to a high school diploma; without the invaluable assistance of Mrs. Hudson, many people would not have otherwise achieved this laudable goal; and

WHEREAS, by going the extra mile to volunteer, Mrs. Hudson has certainly provided many with a brighter future and enhanced their chances to succeed in an institution of higher learning; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Hudson unselfishly gives the center more than 20 hours of service per week and strives to bring forth the best in her students; and

WHEREAS, due to her outstanding efforts and volunteer service, Mrs. Hudson has earned statewide recognition by being selected as the 1994 Outstanding Volunteer of the Year; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE SENATE CONCURRING, That we recognize Virginia Hudson for her outstanding service as a volunteer teacher, while also congratulating her upon being selected as the 1994 Outstanding Volunteer of the Year.
