BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 16-17-102, is amended by adding the  
following sentence at the end of the section:

Alternatively, these city judges may be selected under the method prescribed in  
the home rule charter, or elected as provided in Title 16, Chapter 18, Part 2.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring  
it.
