AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 36, Chapter 6, relative to child visitation.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 36, Chapter 6, Part 3, is amended by adding a new section thereto, as follows:

Section _____. Any parent convicted of a sexual offense pursuant to title 39, chapter 13, part 5, or of sexual exploitation of a minor pursuant to title 39, chapter 17, part 10, who does not have custody of a child, or in the case of parents having joint custody of a child, is not the parent residing with the child, or if the child is in the custody of a legal guardian, then such parent shall not have unsupervised visitation with the child. Before such parent can exercise visitation with the child, the court shall appoint a person of good moral character and reputation who shall accompany the child at all times visitation by the parent is exercised.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
