AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 8-34-605(c), relative to retirement credit for peacetime military service.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 8-34-605(c), is amended by adding the following at the end thereof:

Notwithstanding this subsection or any other provision of law to the contrary, any member or retired member who performed peacetime military service in the armed forces of the United States at any time before October 15, 1940 or after May 7, 1975 shall be entitled to establish retirement credit for such military service under the conditions set forth in this subsection, unless such individual is a member or retired member by virtue of employment with an employer participating in the retirement system pursuant to chapter 35, part 2 of this title. To be eligible for such credit, the chief governing body of the employer must pass and file with the board of trustees a resolution authorizing the credit and accepting the liability therefor.

SECTION 2. Implementation of the provisions of this act shall be subject to the funding being provided in the general appropriations act.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
