

SENATE BILL 3052

AN ACT relative to changing the boundary line between Sevier and Blount Counties.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. The boundary line between Sevier and Blount Counties shall be changed in a manner to include in District 9 of Sevier County, Tennessee the following described properties presently located in District 13 of Blount County, Tennessee:

(1) The Norton property recorded in Warranty Deed Book 367, Page 423, being 0.525 acres more or less;

(2) The Inman property recorded in Warranty Deed Book 331, Page 402, being 0.419 acres more or less;

(3) The Gibson property recorded in Warranty Deed Book 287, Page 136, being 0.464 acres more or less; and

(4) The Gibson property recorded in Warranty Deed Book 214, Page 91, being 0.333 acres more or less;

all of which such property is shown on Tax Map 4 and 4E, Blount County/Tax Map 44, Sevier County and as shown on the boundary survey and plat map dated 24 January, 1996, a copy of which is attached hereto.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
