A RESOLUTION to honor and thank Ms. Patricia Wright as a member of the Citizens Commission on Government Officials' Compensation.

WHEREAS, Public Chapter 460 of the Acts of 1993, codified as Tennessee Code Annotated § 8-24-118, created a temporary commission known as the Citizens Commission on Government Officials' Compensation for the purpose of studying duties and responsibilities of certain county officials and making recommendations regarding appropriate compensation; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Patricia Wright served as a member of the Citizens Commission on Government Officials' Compensation

WHEREAS, as a member of the Citizens Commission on Government Officials' Compensation Ms. Wright traveled to Nashville to convene to study the compensation of certain county officials and to develop recommendations on their appropriate compensation; and

WHEREAS, as a member of the Commission, Ms. Wright exemplified the spirit of public service by volunteering her time and expertise; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Wright's employer, Opryland Hotel, contributed to the partnership between government and the private sector by providing Ms. Wright with leave to participate in the work of the Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Commission produced its report specifying its recommendations on February 1, 1995 as required by law; and

WHEREAS, the Commission's report listed 13 recommendations for improving the methods of compensating certain county officials; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING, That Ms. Patricia Wright, as a member of the Citizens Commission on Government Officials' Compensation, be recognized for her spirit of public service in providing valuable recommendations from the private sector to the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee.
