SUBJECT: **HB 142**

This bill, if enacted, will raise the age for holding an unrestricted driver license from 16 to 18 years of age. At age 16, upon compliance with application and examination requirements, a person shall be eligible to hold a restricted license allowing driving between the hours of 6 a.m. and 9 p.m. unless traveling to or from employment, school or there exists an emergency. Class M licenses would be eliminated.

The fiscal impact from enactment of this bill is estimated to be a decrease in state revenues as a result of issuing fewer licenses but such decrease is estimated not to be significant.
