SUBJECT: **HB 331 - SB 433**

This bill, if enacted, will provide for the issuance of a restricted driver license for all violations listed under TCA 55-50-501. This includes the commission of a felony involving use of a vehicle, leaving the scene of an accident involving injury or death, altering or fraudulent use of a license, theft of a vehicle, etc.

The fiscal impact from enactment of this bill is estimated to be a recurring increase in state expenditures of \$16,200 and a one-time increase of \$3,000.

The enactment of this bill is also estimated to result in an increase in state revenue of \$40,200 from the collection of additional restricted driver license fees of \$67 each from a projected 600 applicants.
