SUBJECT: **HB 611 - SB 992**

This bill, if enacted, will provide that if a physician or medical examiner does not complete the medical certification within a timely manner, then a complaint may be filed with the Board of Medical Examiners and the physician or medical examiner may be subject to a civil penalty of no more than \$100.

The fiscal impact from enactment of this bill is estimated to be an increase in state revenues from the collection of additional fines, since this bill clarifies that a civil penalty can be assessed; however, the amount of such increase is estimated not to be significant.
