SUBJECT: **HB 1783 - SB 1772**

This bill, if enacted, will authorize the Commissioner of the Department of Human Services to implement changes necessary as a result of federal legislation which may be passed to reform welfare programs currently, or in the future, which are administered by the Department of Human Services or other state agencies. Such changes could be implemented by public necessity rules, as provided for in the bill.

The fiscal impact from enactment of this bill cannot be reasonably determined since it will depend on federal welfare reform legislation that is passed, and enacted under the provisions of this bill. To the extent that welfare reform legislation results in less federal revenues available to the state for welfare programs, the fiscal impact from enactment of this bill is estimated to result in an increase in state expenditures in excess of \$100,000 unless actions can be taken under the provisions of this bill to reduce welfare benefits to offset losses of federal revenues.
