SUBJECT: **HB 2104 - SB 2336**

This bill, if enacted, will prohibit employees of the Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation, community mental health agencies and community mental retardation agencies from establishing a relationship which would be a conflict of interest between the employee's interest, the best interest of the client and the duties and policies of the department. The bill provides a civil penalty of \$1,500.

The fiscal impact from enactment of this bill is estimated to be an increase in state revenue for civil penalties imposed. The amount of such increase is estimated to be not significant.
