SUBJECT: **HB 2228 - SB 2492**

This bill, if enacted, will revise the license requirements for persons requesting to become licensed employee assistance professional in Tennessee and allows out-of-state employee assistance professionals to become state licensed in Tennessee.

The fiscal impact from enactment of this bill is estimated to result in an increase in state revenue from the increase in fees from people becoming certified as employee assistant professionals; however, such increase cannot be determined but is estimated not to exceed \$100,000.
