SUBJECT: **HB 2295 - SB 2600**

This bill, if enacted, establishes a standard uniform for constables. Uniforms may be provided either by the constable or the county.

The fiscal impact on local governments from enactment of this bill in and of itself is estimated to be minimal since the provisions of the bill are permissive.

The fiscal impact of this bill is estimated to result in an increase in local government expenditures to the extent that counties choose to provide uniforms to constables. The amount of such increase cannot be determined but is estimated to be not significant.
