SUBJECT: **HB 2485 - SB 2864**

This bill, if enacted, will require the Department of Human Services to establish a licensing system for "adult day health care centers". The department would initiate criminal background checks of center employees prior to licensing. The department is required to issue a provisional license for one year to new centers to allow them to meet license requirements. The department is to charge a \$500 annual fee for licensing or renewal.

The fiscal impact of this bill is estimated to increase state expenditures \$116,500; \$100,400 in recurring expenditures and \$16,100 one-time for staff to issue licenses and inspect facilities. The fiscal impact of this bill is also estimated to increase state revenues based upon collection of the annual licensing fee. However, the amount cannot be determined but is estimated to be not significant.
