SUBJECT: **HB 3300**

This bill, if enacted, will allow county governing bodies to make purchases through federal General Services Administration contracts. Counties currently have no such statutory authority.

The fiscal impact on local governments from enactment of this bill in and of itself is estimated to be minimal since the provisions of the bill are permissive.

The fiscal impact from enactment of this bill is estimated to be a decrease in local government expenditures to the extent that the federal government allows such purchases to be made by counties, and to the extent that the purchases through such contracts generate greater savings for counties than could be realized in the absence of this bill. Such decrease cannot be determined but is estimated to be not significant.
