SUBJECT: **HJR 244**

This resolution, if adopted, requests the General Welfare, Health and Human Resources Committee of the Senate and the Health and Human Resources Committee of the House of Representatives to jointly examine and evaluate the programs and activities of the Sarcoidosis Research Institute, Memphis, and to determine the desirability and feasibility of providing state grants to the institute to help address sarcoidosis issues in Tennessee.

The committees shall submit their joint report not later than January 9, 1996, for action by the General Assembly.

The fiscal impact from adoption of this resolution is estimated to be minimal.
