SUBJECT: **HJR 448**

This resolution, if adopted, creates a special joint committee to study the funding and operation of community mental health agencies.

The special joint committee shall be composed of three (3) Senators and three (3) Representatives. The special joint committee shall timely report its findings and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the One Hundredth General Assembly no later than February 1, 1997, at which time the committee shall cease to exist.

The fiscal impact from adoption of this resolution is estimated to be an increase in state expenditures of \$952 for each one day meeting of the committee. Details are shown below:

Per Diem ( 6 members x \$90)	540
Average round-trip mileage 6 members x 286 miles x \$.24)	<u>412</u>
Average Estimated Increase in State Expenditures for Each One Day Meeting	<u>\$952</u>
