SUBJECT: **HR 154**

This resolution, if adopted, limits the use of the legislative voice mail system. The system is not to be used during the regular legislative session and any subsequent special session, from Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. The resolution also provides that voice mail use will be permitted after 4:30 p.m. during session and anytime between legislative sessions.

The fiscal impact from adoption of this resolution is estimated to be an increase in one-time state expenditures of approximately \$65,000 and recurring state expenditures of approximately \$11,000 to install a separate voice mail system for the House of Representatives with the capability to be turned off and on manually at the designated times.
