SUBJECT: **SB 0009 - HB 0033**

This bill, if enacted, will allow all judges to sentence those convicted for second-time DUI to a work release program, according to certain conditions and if adopted by a two-thirds vote of the legislative body of such county. Currently such work release is an option only in Shelby County and counties with a metropolitan form of government (Moore and Davidson). In addition, present law provides for prisoners on work release to reimburse the county for the cost of incarceration.

The fiscal impact from enactment of this bill is estimated to be an increase in local government revenues and expenditures; however, such increases will depend on the number of persons sentenced to work release and their ability to pay. Therefore, the increase in local government revenues and expenditures, if any, cannot be determined but is estimated not to be significant.
