SUBJECT: **SB 603 - HB 608**

This bill, if enacted, will extend the 25% tuition discount to any child under the age of 24 whose parent holds any valid professional certification and is employed by any public school system.

The fiscal impact from enactment of this bill is estimated to be a decrease in school revenues of approximately \$2,100.

According to the State Department of Education, there are approximately 100 persons employed by public school systems throughout the state who are not participants under the current law. At an assumed 6% participation rate among the children of these new participants, the number of students who would receive discounts equals approximately six children at an average cost of \$350 per child.
