SUBJECT: **SB 921**

This bill, if enacted, will require the Select Oversight Committee on Education to conduct an indepth review of the situation involving testing, assessment and accountability measurement procedures in grades K-12. In conducting its review, the committee may, with the approval of the speakers, contract with or employ experts in the field of testing and evaluation or such other experts as the committee may find necessary. The committee may also seek the assistance of any agency of state government including state institutions of higher education.

The fiscal impact from enactment of this bill is estimated to be an increase in state expenditures to the extent experts are hired to assist the committee. The amount of such increase cannot be reasonably determined but is estimated not to be significant.
