SUBJECT: **SB 1167 - HB 1333**

This bill, if enacted, will provide to all firefighters, emergency service employees and other employees of the fire department, as well as firefighting organizations, the right to meet, confer and to negotiate wages, hours and conditions of employment with representatives of their governmental employer.

The fiscal impact from enactment of this bill is estimated to be an increase in local government* expenditures and will depend upon the negotiations conducted and any agreements binding on local governments which would not have occurred in the absence of the bill. A reasonable estimate of the increased expenditures cannot be determined but is estimated to exceed \$100,000.
