SUBJECT: **SB 1391 - HB 1089**

This bill, if enacted, will increase the punishment for simple assault when there is bodily injury and the victim is a law enforcement officer from a Class A misdemeanor to a Class E felony.

The fiscal impact from enactment of this bill is estimated to be an increase in state expenditures of \$213,950 for incarceration*. This estimate is based upon 50 convictions every year receiving a sentence of one year with 30% or 110 days actually being served at a cost of \$38.90 per day.
