SUBJECT: **SB 1478 - HB 1423**

This bill, if enacted, will allow a judge to assess a fine of up to \$50 or five hours of community service work against the parents or guardians of any child under seven years of age who is absent more than five days of any school year without an adequate excuse.

The fiscal impact from enactment of this bill is estimated to be minimal, since the judge is authorized but not required to assess a fine of up to \$50 against certain parents or guardians. However, to the extent fines are assessed and collected against parents for violations local government revenues will increase. Such increase is estimated to be not significant.
